16. Narrative (List all damages, injuries, estimates and a synopsis of the facts)					
<p>I, OFFICER MITCHELL WAS STANDING AT 1307 UNIVERSITY BL TALKING WITH SEVERAL UAPD OFFICERS AND THE MANAGER FROM JUPITER ABOUT A CITATION HE HAD BEEN WRITTEN EARLIER IN THE EVENING FOR HAVING ONE UNDER AGE PERSON IN HIS BAR WITH ALCOHOL. WHILE STANDING THERE TALKING I HEARD SOMEONE YELL "F***" AND I TURNED TO SEE A BLACK MALE STANDING IN THE STREET YELLING AT A GREEN SUV TRYING TO DRIVE EAST ON UNIVERSITY BL. THE SUSPECT WAS STANDING BESIDE THE REAR PASSENGER DOOR AND THE SUV WAS NOT DRIVING AWAY WHILE THE SUSPECT WAS YELLING, CAUSING TRAFFIC TO BACK UP ON UNIVERSITY BL. I ALSO NOTICED THAT THERE WAS A LARGE CROWD STANDING ON THE SIDEWALK NEXT TO THE SUSPECT THAT WAS YELL AT THE SUV WATCHING AND LISTENING TO WHAT WAS TAKING PLACE. THE SUSPECT CONTINUED TO CUSS AT THE PASSENGERS AND CHALLENGE THEN TO FIGHT IN THE STREET WITH HIS WORDS AND NON-VERBAL LANGUAGE. I DO NOT REMEMBER THE EXACT WORDS HE WAS SAYING BUT THE MEANING WAS TO GET OUT OF THE SUV AND FIGHT IN THE STREET WHERE THEY WERE STANDING. THE SUSPECT WAS SAYING "F***" REPEATEDLY AND USING SEVERAL OTHER CUSS WORDS SUCH AS "BITCH." THE SUSPECT'S NON-VERBAL AGGRESSIVE CLUES INCLUDED HIS TONE OF VOICE: HE WAS SHOUTING VERY LOUDLY IN A DEEP AGGRESSIVE TONE OF VOICE. HE WAS LOUD ENOUGH TO BE HEARD ALMOST A BLOCK AWAY OVER 5 CARS AND A CROWD OF AT LEAST 200 PEOPLE THAT WERE BETWEEN US. THE OTHER CLUES INCLUDED HIS BOUNCING BACK AND FORTH IN THE STREET AND RAISING HIS HAND IN THE AIR AS IF TO SAY HERE I AM COME GET ME. HE WAS ALSO WAVING COME HERE WITH HIS FINGERS WHILE HIS HANDS WERE IN THE AIR. MY RESPONSE TIME TO THE INCIDENT WAS A MATTER OF SECONDS AFTER I HEARD THE FIRST SHOUTS. AS SOON AS I STARTED TOWARD THE INCIDENT THE SUV MADE A LEFT TURN ONTO 13TH AVE WHERE THE SUSPECT RAN ACROSS THE CORNER OF THE SIDEWALK AND CONTINUED YELLING AND</p>

WAS ACTING WAS EMBARRASSING TO THE SCHOOL AND TEAM. THE SUSPECT THEN STATED THAT IT WAS EMBARRASSING TO HIS FAMILY AND HIMSELF AS WELL. NOTHING FURTHER WAS SAID WHILE ENROUTE TO SPC. ONCE IN SPC OFFICER DANIEL WALKED IN AND TOLD THE SUSPECT THAT HE WAS A FAN BUT DISAPPOINTED THAT HE HAD ACTED IN THAT MANNER AND WAS ARRESTED FOR DISORDERLY CONDUCT. OFFICER DANIEL MADE A FEW STATEMENTS BUT I DO NOT REMEMBER WHAT THEY WERE. THE SUSPECT STATED THAT THIS WAS GOING TO HURT HURT HIS DRAFT STATUS AND SQUATTED AGAINST THE WALL AND APPEARED TO BE CRYING. THE SUSPECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE COUNTY JAIL SHORTLY AFTER THIS. NO FURTHER CONVERSATION OCCURRED BETWEEN THE TWO OF US. I WAS ADVISED THAT SOMEONE MADE THE STATEMENT " WHAT IS SABAN GOING TO THINK ABOUT THIS" I DO NOT REMEMBER THOSE WORDS BEING SPOKEN BUT IT COULD HAVE BEEN SAID WHILE MY ATTENTION WAS DIVERTED ELSEWHERE STANDING ON 13TH AVE BY ONE OF THE UA OFFICERS, OR BY OFFICER DANIEL IN SPC WHILE I WAS TYPING THE ARREST REPORT AND NOT LISTENING TO THEIR CONVERSATION. I DO KNOW THAT I DID NOT MAKE THAT STATEMENT. I NEVER SPOKE TO THE PASSENGERS IN THE SUV. SGT MCMILLIAN OF UAPD SPOKE WITH THEM AND I DID NOT SEE HIM AFTER I ESCORTED THE SUSPECT TO MY PATROL CAR SO I AM UNAWARE OF WHAT THEY HAD TO SAY. I ALSO DID NOT HEAR ANY TYPE OF SHOUTING COMING FROM THE SUV. THE ONLY FAULT I SEE ON THE SUV WAS ITS FAILURE TO DRIVE OFF. THE DRIVER MADE THE DECISION TO STOP IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD WHILE THE SUSPECT YELLED AT HIM AND HIS PASSENGERS WHEN HE COULD HAVE SIMPLY DROVE OFF AND HELPED CLEAR UP TRAFFIC AND DEFUSE WHAT APPEARED TO BE AN UGLY FIGHT WAITING TO HAPPEN IN THE MIDDLE OF UNIVERSITY BL.

I, OFFICER MITCHELL WAS STANDING AT 1307 UNIVERSITY BL WHEN I HEARD SOMEONE SHOUTING "FUCK" VERY LOUDLY. I TURNED TO SEE A BLACK MALE SHOUTING AT A GREEN SUV THAT WAS TRYING TO DRIVE EAST ON UNIVERSITY BL. THE SUSPECT CONTINUED TO YELL "FUCK" AND CHALLENGE THE PEOPLE IN THE SUV TO FIGHT HIM. THE SUSPECT WAS BOUNCING AROUND IN THE STREET AND THROWING HIS ARMS IN THE AIR WHILE YELLING LOUDLY AT THE SUV. THE SUV WAS NOT MOVING WHILE THE SUSPECT WAS YELLING AT IT AND IT APPEARED THAT THE PARTIES WERE GOING TO FIGHT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREET. WHILE THIS WAS GOING ON TRAFFIC WAS BACKING UP BEHIND THE SUV FROM 13TH AVE BACK TO THE 1600 BLOCK OF UNIVERSITY BL AT THE LEAST. THERE WAS ALSO AT LEAST 200 PEOPLE CROWDED AROUND THE SIDEWALK WHILE THE SUSPECT WAS YELLING AT THE SUV WATCHING THE INCIDENT. WHEN OFFICERS STARTED WALKING TOWARDS THE SUSPECT THE SUV TURNED ONTO 13TH AVE AND THE SUSPECT CONTINUED TO YELL "FUCK" AND CHALLENGE THE PEOPLE INSIDE TO A FIGHT. AT ONE POINT THE SUSPECT HAD TO RUN TO KEEP UP WITH THE SUV WHEN IT MADE THE TURN AND I RAN TO CATCH THE SUSPECT WHO WAS ATTRACTING MORE PEOPLE FROM ACROSS THE STREET. ONCE IN REACH I GRABBED THE SUSPECTS LEFT ARM AND TURNED HIM TO FACE THE WEST SIDE OF 13TH AVE AND ESCORTED HIM TO THE SIDEWALK. THE SUSPECT WAS THEN IDENTIFIED AS SIMEON CASTILLE. CASTILLE STATED THAT HE WAS NOT TRYING TO FIGHT BUT JUST PLAYING WITH HIS TEAMMATES. CASTILLE WAS ADVISED THAT HE WAS BEING ARRESTED FOR DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND THAT THE BOND WAS \$500. HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO SPC FOR PROCESSING AND LATER PLACED IN THE COUNTY JAIL PENDING BOND.
